Worship

NURSERY is provided for children up to 5 years of age during Sunday worship services and special church events. All caregivers are screened and complete child abuse prevention training prior to employment. The Nursery can be found in the front hallway off Surface Hall. Please ask a Host or Usher if you need assistance.

CHILDREN'S CHURCH occurs during the 10:00 AM worship service and is for children age

3 years old through 3^{rd} grade. The children follow the cross out during the singing of the *Gloria* and return during the welcome and announcements.

THE CHILDREN'S WORSHIP PACKETS contain activity sheets and crayons/colored pencils for children to use during worship. They are located beside the stairs to the sacristy in Surface Hall just outside the nave. Please return them after the service.

THE CHILDREN'S QUIET BOOKS are handmade, felt and laminated books for use by children during worship services and can be found on a rack in Surface Hall. Parents and kids are encouraged to use these books during services. We ask that they be used gently and returned at the end of each service.

ASSISTED LISTENING DEVICES are available and located at the back of the church in a basket on a table near the front door. If you have slight to moderate hearing loss, you may benefit from the use of an assisted listening device. The devices serve as receivers for the church's speaker system transmitter. Simply place the earbud (earbuds) in your ear (ears), turn the volume control wheel to activate the device, and adjust the sound volume for maximum comfort and listening clarity. All devices are maintained and cleaned regularly. Questions pertaining to these devices and CEC's Deaf and Hard of Hearing Ministry can be directed to Terry and/or Miliska Knauft.

SEPTEMBER L.O.F.T. (Living our Faith Together) - will begin on Wednesday, September 5th. For adults and youth, there are two offerings:

The Way of Love is led by the Rev. Dr. Steve Pankey in Moore Hall. Learn in community about Presiding Bishop Michael Curry's invitation to follow "the loving, liberating, life giving way of Jesus" by incorporating 7 practices (learn, pray, worship, bless, go, rest, turn) into everyday life.

Seeking Shalom is led by Deacon Kellie Mysinger in the Conference Room. Seeking Shalom examines why traditional models of addressing poverty are not working and presents a biblical framework for understanding poverty and reveals the five core principles for having real and lasting impact. There is a \$15 material fee, but scholarships are available upon request. Note: This class will continue for 2 weeks longer than the other LOFT classes.

The Way of Love for Children is led by Laura Goodwin and Linda Mitchell in St. Anne's Children's Church Room. Also exploring The Way of Love, through creative artistic reflections, movement, and fellowship, children will have a better understanding of how to incorporate the 7 practices (learn, pray, worship, bless, go, rest, turn) into everyday life. Children Kindergarten - 5th grade are welcome. A nursery is provided for those under the age of 5.

Living Waters for the World (LWW)

LWW empowers everyday people to change lives through clean water. November 2-11 our mission team will embark on a trip to install a water purification system in a medical clinic that services three communities on the Amazon River in Peru who currently exist without any access to clean water. The system will capture rainwater from the roof and using solar power, pass the water through a series of filters and UV light that will purify the water. The team will also educate the people using spiritual modules as well as basic health and hygiene lessons. Team members are: Jan Funk, Laura Goodwin, Laurie Joyce, Belinda and Digby Palmer, John Parker, and Gary Reimer.
