EDUCATION FOR MINISTRY One of the most exciting and rewarding ministries at Christ Church is Education for Ministry (EFM). Exciting because it offers the opportunity to explore in depth one's faith and how that faith manifests itself in everyday life. Rewarding because one not only gains knowledge about Scripture but also the history of the Church and various theological perspectives.

However, one of the best benefits, if not THE best, is the relationship one develops with their fellow participants. A spirit of open discussion, confidentiality, and loving listening make the weekly sessions eagerly anticipated.

Christ Church has had a very strong EFM program for many years and is one of the few congregations offering both a morning and evening schedule, so everyone can take advantage.

The program is offered through the University of the South in Sewanee, TN, and is completed locally over four years. Years one and two focus on the Hebrew Scriptures and the New Testament respectively. The year three focus is on the history of the Church going back to its beginnings. Year four allows an examination of various theological ideas. Each of these topics also serves to lead the group into wide ranging and thought provoking discussions.

If you are looking for a way to both broaden and deepen your knowledge as well as develop deep and abiding friendships, EFM is just for you.

In partnership with the three other downtown Christian churches, we attempt to assist families with their electric bill, emergency prescriptions, gasoline for an out of town doctor appointment, etc. For the past several months, the NEED has far exceeded our resources to help. In order to effectively sustain this ministry we need for members to step up with a pledge of \$10 or more per week. The Help Ministry at Christ Church currently distributes about \$1,000 per month to those in need using a voucher system. We only help an individual once every 12 months. RESTROOM AND HANDWASHING STATION Christ Church is proud to partner with HOTEL, INC., Hope House, and the Warren County Office of Emergency Management to serve as one of five locations for a temporary restroom and handwashing station. Located in the alley between CEC and the Public Library, this station will allow our neighbors experiencing homelessness a place to use safe and sanitary restroom facilities as well as wash their hands.
