CHURCHES UNITED IN CHRIST HELP MINISTRY is one of the oldest outreach ministries of Christ Church. In partnership with the three other downtown Christian churches, we attempt to assist families with their electric bill, emergency prescriptions, gasoline for an out of town doctor appointment, etc. For the past several months, the NEED has far exceeded our resources to help. In order to effectively sustain this ministry we need for members to step up with a pledge of \$10 or more per week. The Help Ministry at Christ Church currently distributes about \$1,000 per month to those in need using a voucher system. We only help an individual once every 12 months. WEDNESDAY COMMUNITY LUNCH is working to help the Salvation Army provide lunch and dinner to its clients and the wider community. HOTEL, INC. has seen a 174% increase in requests for food boxes from the Manna Mart. Street Medicine Teams are working to help our neighbor experiencing homelessness to follow CDC protocols for physical distancing and sanitation. The needs will only increase. Donations to HOTEL, INC. can help support their work as well as help them plan ahead for the ways in which layoffs across many industries will impact poverty and homelessness.

RESTROOM AND HANDWASHING STATION Christ Church is proud to partner with HOTEL, INC., Hope House, and the Warren County Office of Emergency Management to serve as one of five locations for a temporary restroom and handwashing station. Located in the alley between CEC and the Public Library, this station will allow our neighbors experiencing homelessness a place to use safe and sanitary restroom facilities as well as wash their hands.

BOWLING GREEN COVID-19 ACTION CENTER WKU Geography staff and students, the City of Bowling Green, Warren County government and the Warren County Sheriff's Office, with additional assistance provided as needed by BGCAN (Bowling Green Coalition of Active Neighborhoods) board members are helping residents and businesses come together to support those in need during the COVID-19 Pandemic.
