### *Worship*

**NURSERY** is provided for children up to 5 years of age from 8:45 AM to 11:15 AM and special church events. All caregivers are screened and complete child abuse prevention training prior to employment. The Nursery can be found in the front hallway off Surface Hall. Please ask a Host or Usher if you need assistance.

**CHILDREN'S CHURCH** occurs during the 10:00 AM worship service and is for children age 3 years old through 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. The children follow the cross out during the singing of the *Gloria* and return during the welcome and announcements.

**CHILDREN'S WORSHIP PACKETS** contain activity sheets and crayons/colored pencils for children to use during worship. They are located beside the stairs to the sacristy in Surface Hall just outside the nave. Please return them after the service.

**CHILDREN'S QUIET BOOKS** are handmade, felt and laminated books for use by children during worship services and can be found on a rack in Surface Hall. Parents and kids are encouraged to use these books during services. We ask that they be used gently and returned at the end of each service.

**ASSISTED LISTENING DEVICES** are available and located at the back of the church in a basket on a table near the front door. These devices are free for use by parishioners, or guests, who range from being slightly to profoundly hard of hearing. The receivers pick up the wireless FM broadcast of all the lay and clergy speakers using microphones and reduce room echoes and other distracting sounds. Those not using hearing aids can listen to the receiver with the attached ear buds. Listeners who have hearing aids with a telecoil (telephone coil T-switch) setting option can use the receiver with a neck loop telecoil coupler. The loudness of sound can be adjusted with the volume control wheel located at the top of the receiver. Please stop by the bulletin board in Surface Hall and check-out the information under the Deaf and Hard of Hearing Ministry sign. ## *Learn and Grow*

**ADULT FORUM MARCH 22** Tsering Phuntok, practicing Buddhist monk and international visitor of parishioner Ken Casey, will offer an adult forum in Moore Hall on Sunday, March 22 at 9 AM on the topic “Pilgrimage.” His training in the the Nyingmapa tradition of Tibetan Buddhism equipped him to train other monks in ritual and academic subjects. He has also received teachings from His Holiness the Dalia Lama, who is his neighbor living only one mile away in the Temple, and other High Lamas. He is currently working on health-related projects for his monastery. We are so happy to receive him as he makes his way around Kentucky as a resident teacher.

**L.O.F.T. IN LENT** continues on Wednesdays through April 1. Classes are available for adults and children. **CONTAGIOUS DISEASES IN CHURCH** - Still in the midst of a severe flu season and with increased attention on the Coronavirus (COVID-19) and its spread around the globe, Episcopal Relief and Development and the Diocese of Kentucky have issued some basic guidelines for preventing the spread of contagious diseases in church. On our end, Christ Church will make hand sanitizer available at the two main entrances to the Nave, as well as having it in Surface and Moore Halls. Clergy distributing wafers will sanitize their hands after the Peace to ensure the safety of our communicants. To help us all out, we ask that you follow a few simple guidelines as well.

- If you are sick, please stay home.
- Wash your hands after using the restroom, coughing or sneezing, and before handling food.
- If you feel uncomfortable shaking hands, a wave hello or eye contact and a hand on your heart at the Peace are certainly acceptable alternatives.

Finally, studies have shown that when it is wiped with a clean purificator and rotated after each communicant, sipping from the common cup, whether it is silver or ceramic, is the most sanitary way to receive the consecrated wine at communion. If you would prefer to intinct, please ensure that your fingers do not dip into the wine or tap the inside of the chalice. Also, please remember that receiving in one kind, that is bread or wine only, does not diminish the efficacy of the Eucharist. God's ability to impart grace exists well beyond our need to prevent the spread of communicable diseases.
