Dr. Rebecca D. Shadowen is an infectious disease specialist in Bowling Green, Kentucky and offers this information:

COVID-19 Protections for Volunteers and Retasked Workers

It is unprecedented times with both opportunity and risks for all of us. COVID-19 (Coronavirus) is an infectious disease that is passing through the human species where there is no innate immunity to protect us. Although it will proceed, there are ways to protect ourselves and those around us. It is transmitted by secretions from our mouth and nose. We often touch our face and then carry the infection on our hands which can place them on surfaces. The virus dies after 72 hours on a hard surface.

Here are some points to consider:

1. How Do We Get this Infection:
 - a. Face to face contact within 3 feet for > 30 minutes with a carrier (asymptomatic person)
 - b. Face to face contact within 3 feet for > 5 minutes with an actively infected person (symptomatic)

2. How Do We Avoid this Infection:
 - a. Avoid close face to face contact. Distance 6 feet from others to ensure no secretions from an unanticipated cough or sneeze would reach us.
 - b. Once we have touched common surfaces (such as a delivery item or service area), avoid touching our own face until we can wash our hands or use hand sanitizer, both are effective.
 - c. Clean common service area surfaces after transaction has completed within an effective disinfectant (those will have a label for viricidal activity) or dilute bleach (5 tablespoons in a quart or 1/3 cup in a gallon water) and let dry.

Front desk (9am-4pm).

Custodian help is needed to ensure cleanliness of our facility for our clients and staff.

Food preparation: Prepare lunches, disinfecting the dining room tables and chairs, trash removal, organizing food warehouse, and prepare food boxes.
